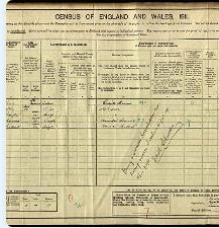


History

Collaborative Learning

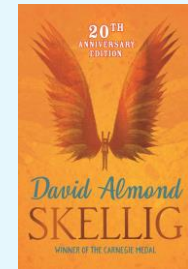
Children will discover how computer networks work and practise collaborating safely and effectively online.
