Are all settlements the same?

Pupils will explore different types of settlements, including villages, towns and cities, and learn why they develop in particular locations.



Science

Living Things: Classification and changing habitats

Children will learn how living things can be grouped in a variety of ways and use classification keys to identify organisms. They will explore different habitats, recognise how environments can change, and consider the impact these changes have on living things.

Pupils will develop teamwork, passing, movement and tactical skills through invasion-style games. They will apply attacking and defending strategies in small-sided games.

Colourful Creatures

Children will develop vocabulary related to animals and colours, building confidence in speaking, listening, reading and writing French. They will use adjectives and simple sentence structures to describe creatures.

Skills Showcase: HTML

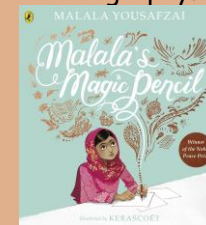
Pupils will learn the basics of HTML, understanding how web pages are structured and coded. They will apply their skills to create and edit simple web pages.

Who was Jesus really?

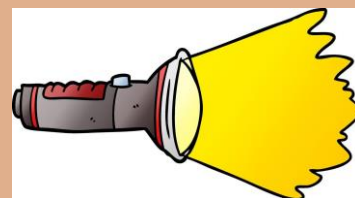
Children will explore different perspectives about Jesus, examining biblical texts and Christian beliefs. They will consider why Jesus is significant to Christians and others today.
